ROAD RUNNERS CLUB NEWS :

1. The various Road Runners Club Associations or groups are being contacted in reference to financial support to have the RRC become incorporated. This would offer protection to individual members as to liabilities.
2. We are investigating methods of measuring road courses. Eventually we hope to establish the practice of awarding Standards Certificates for achieving certain times at a series of distances in competition. The first step is to measure and evaluate courses.
3. The RRC has held one or more national RRC running championships each year. This year a 10 mile road championship was held in Camden, NJ in the Spring. The question of holding a national telegraphic run was discussed but it was decided that it is now too late in the year. The idea is to hold a twilight meet in the middle of the week, each area running off its race on a track on the same day and telephoning or telegraphing results into a designated central area for tabulations and determining the "national" champion. It was recommended that this be tried next year in July or early August when the days are longest. If each area could measure (accurately) a flat road or park course, such a race need not be held on the track.
4. One of the goals of the RRC is the publication of appropriate literature. One of our first efforts in this area is now under way. We are working on four subjects: "Diet and the Athlete"; "A List of All Time Fastest Marathons"; "Measuring Road Racing Courses"; and, "Guide on How to Form an RRC Association". These will be mimeographed and sold at cost (or if possible at a slight profit to help the national treasury).
